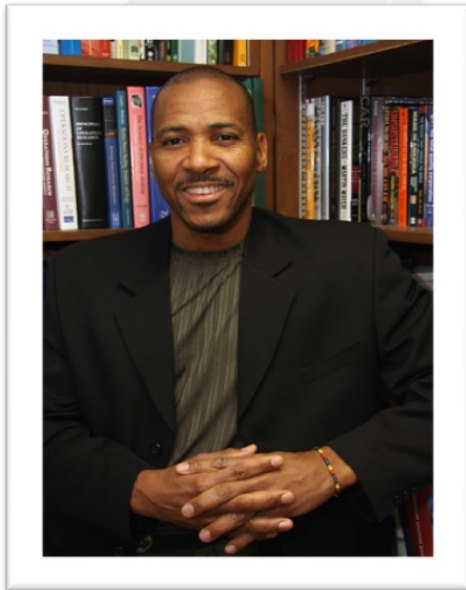




# Awards for Research in the United States



## Types of Awards

*Visiting Research Chairs:* are available to scholars who wish to conduct research and/or teach at one of the Visiting Research Chairs Program's partner universities (see [www.fulbright.ca](http://www.fulbright.ca) for a list of specific opportunities)

*Traditional Scholar Awards:* are available to candidates who plan to conduct research or teach at an American university or research centre of their choice for at least one semester or up to a full academic year

### **Visiting Chairs for Canadian Scholars in the U.S.**

US\$25,000 for one semester

For prominent and promising scholars, and experienced professionals.

To conduct research, develop partnerships, and guest lecture at select partner institutions.

### **Traditional Awards for Canadian Scholars in the U.S.**

US\$12,500 for one semester

For emerging and established scholars, post-doctoral researchers, and experienced professionals.

To conduct research, teach, or undertake a combination of these activities.

Award can be held at any University, Research Centre, Think Tank, or Government Agency in the U.S.

Minimum one semester residence at host.

### **Fulbright Regional Network for Applied Research (NEXUS) Program**

US\$30,000

The Fulbright NEXUS Program brings together a network of junior scholars, professionals and mid-career applied researchers from Western Hemisphere nations for a series of three seminar meetings and a Fulbright residential exchange experience. Through international exchanges, seminars, and collaborative research, up to 20 Fulbright participants (1/3 from the United States, 2/3 from Canada and other countries of the Western Hemisphere) will engage in collaborative thinking, analysis, and problem-solving with a focus on improving the quality of life for communities in the region. Fulbright NEXUS Scholars will conduct individual and team-based research projects designed to generate knowledge-based, policy-oriented solutions with immediate and practical implementation potential at the local, national, or regional levels.

Program themes include: 1) Science, Technology, and Innovation, 2) Entrepreneurship, & 3) Sustainable Energy

### **General Eligibility Requirements**

Canadian Citizenship at time of application.

Limited U.S. experience.

Hold a Ph.D. or equivalent professional/terminal degree by December 31, 2011 or have equivalent professional experience.

Proficiency in English.

NOTE: Minimum 5 year period between awards. Lifetime maximum of 2 Fulbright Scholar awards.

Faculty sabbatical, leave-of-absence, or retirement pay may be used concurrently with Fulbright support.

SSHRC, NSERC, and other similar awards can be held coincident with a Fulbright.

Selection is open and competitive, based on a combination of the proposed program of research, academic and professional background, personal statement, letters of reference, and adherence to the aims of the Canada-U.S. Fulbright Program.

Fulbright Canada is committed to recognizing the inherent dignity and worth of every person, and to the provision of equal rights and opportunities without discrimination of any kind. All applicants will be considered without regard to race, religion, ancestry, color, ethnic origin, creed, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, family status, or handicap.
